GLYCOPYRROLATE CREAM - TOPICAL

(GLY-KO-PI-RO-LATE)

USES

This medication is used to help control gustatory excessive sweating or gustatory hyperhidrosis. Can also be used for diabetic and compensatory gustatory hyperhidrosis or Frey's syndrome. Not for use in generalized or whole body excessive sweating conditions.

It is recommended to begin treatment using the 1% formulation. If treatment response is inadequate, the 2% formulation can subsequently be initiated.

HOW TO USE

Use this medication on the skin only. The affected area should be dry before the medication is applied.

Avoid getting the medication into your eyes, mouth, or nose. Do not apply it to broken, irritated, or recently shaved skin. If you do get the medication in those areas, flush with plenty of water.

Apply/wipe a thin layer of this medication to the affected area, usually once daily at bedtime. DryDerm G can also be applied twice daily or on alternate days depending on treatment response. Do not wash the area for 3 to 4 hours after each application.

SIDE EFFECTS

Very few significant side effects have been reported.

Topical administration of sodium bicarbonate or a low-dose corticosteroid (0.5-1% hydrocortisone) may be used to limit or treat skin irritation.

A very serious allergic reaction to this drug is rare. However, seek immediate medical attention if you notice any symptoms of a serious allergic reaction, including: rash, itching/swelling (especially of the face / tongue / throat), severe dizziness, trouble breathing.

PRECAUTIONS

Do not use this medication if you are pregnant or planning to become pregnant. It is not known whether this medication passes into breast milk. Avoid use if you are breast-feeding.

Do not use this cream if you have narrow angle glaucoma.

Do not share this medication with others.

OVERDOSE

This medicine may be harmful if swallowed. If swallowing or overdose is suspected, contact your poison control center or emergency room immediately. INGREDIENTS

Glycopyrrolate, purified water, propylene glycol, petrolatum, dicapryl ether, glyceryl stearate, glycerin, dimethicone, cetyl alcohol, sweet almond oil, tocopheryl acetate, acrylates, phenoxyethanol, benzyl alcohol, disodium EDTA, sodium hydroxide.

STORAGE

Store at room temperature between 59-86°F (15-30°C) away from heat. Product shelf-life will be extended if refrigerated. Keep container tightly closed. Keep all medicines away from children and pets.

AVAILABILITY

DryDerm G is available as wipes in either a 1% or 2% strength.

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
